PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A Variance application to reduce the minimum lot size in the AG-40 (General Agriculture, 40acre minimum) zone from 40 acres in order to facilitate a Minor Subdivision to subdivide an existing 31.08-acre parcel into a 2-acre parcel and a 29.1-acre parcel. 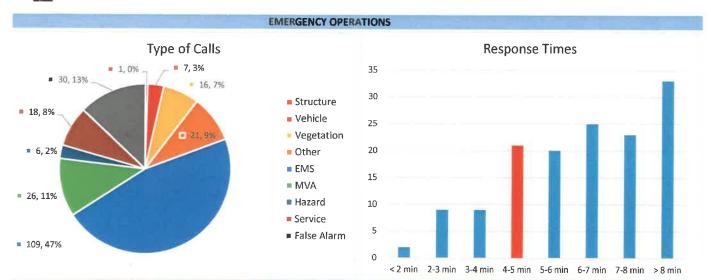

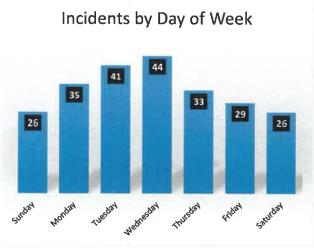

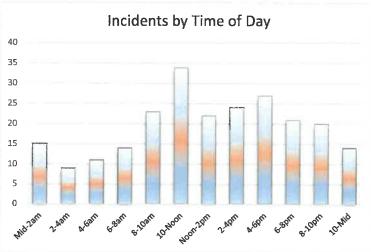
